GREEN INITIATIVES

With the development and installation of a solar farm on five acres of airport property, CAE has been designated as a certified green business. The solar farm enables CAE to receive annual rebates, offsetting annual electrical costs by an average of \$279,987.



AIR CARGO

CAE has the largest air cargo operation in South Carolina and handles 38% of the state's cargo volume. In 2018, FexEX and UPS - the two main cargo carriers on-site - handled over 135 million pounds of freight.



AIRPORT PROPERTY

Vacant sites are adjacent to the airport and/or located within minutes of three major interstates - making it an ideal location for manufacturing, warehousing or distribution.
