CLT continues to be [one of the fastest growing airports in the country](#). Throughout the past 10 years, passenger traffic at CLT has soared 76 percent and operations have grown 28 percent.



Charlotte Douglas made history last year serving 44.28 million travelers – the largest passenger traffic numbers in airport history. It's a 2 percent jump from 2013, which saw 43.46 million people flying through CLT.
