


# WHY CENTRAL SC?



# **CITY OF COLUMBIA**



#### South Carolina State House

HOME TO SOUTH CAROLINA'S LEGISLATIVE HUB, THE BUILDING HOUSES THE STATE GENERAL ASSEMBLY AND THE OFFICES OF THE GOVERNOR AND LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR OF SOUTH CAROLINA.

#### The Vista

BOASTING OVER 100+ RESTAURANTS, GALLERIES, SHOPS AND BARS IN THE HEART OF THE COUNTY, THE VISTA IS A PERFECT SPOT FOR ENTERTAINMENT AND BUSINESS.

#### **Riverbanks Zoo & Garden**

THE RIVERBANKS ZOO AND GARDEN IS A 170-ACRE ZOO, AQUARIUM, AND BOTANICAL GARDEN LOCATED ALONG THE SALUDA RIVER IN COLUMBIA. IT HAS REPEATEDLY BEEN RANKED AS ONE OF THE STATE'S TOP ATTRACTIONS.

#### Williams-Brice Stadium

#### **Bustling Urban Marketplace**



#### Segra Park at BullStreet District
