


WHY CENTRAL SC?





Winnsboro Town Clock

KNOWN AS THE LONGEST-RUNNING CLOCK IN THE UNITED STATES, THE WINNSBORO TOWN CLOCK WAS CONSTRUCTED IN THE LATE 1830S WITHIN THE TOWN'S NEWLY ESTABLISHED MARKET CENTER.

Winnsboro Historic District

CHARTERED IN 1785, WYNNSBOROUGH, LATER RENAMED TO WINNSBORO, IS FAIRFIELD COUNTY'S SEAT. THE HISTORIC DISTRICT IS COMPRISED OF STRUCTURES DATING BACK TO SOME OF THE TOWN'S EARLIEST DAYS. THE DISTRICT INCLUDES THE WINNSBORO CLOCK, FAMED AS THE LONGEST CONTINUOUSLY RUNNING CLOCK IN THE NATION.

South Carolina Railroad Museum (Rockton, Rion & Western Railroad)
