At A Glance: KERSHAW COUNTY

Formed in 1791, Kershaw County was named after early settler Joseph Kershaw. The county seat, Camden, is the oldest inland city in South Carolina, full of history and culture. Kershaw County's close proximity to the state's capital city of Columbia allows it to take advantage of its highly skilled workforce, transportation infrastructure, and quality of life amenities. With a leading rail-served megasite, a growing technical college that's developing a strong worker pipeline, and more than half a million workers in a 60-minute drive time, Kershaw County is business ready.



INFRASTRUCTURE

The Central SC Region is home to four major interstates, all easily accessible throughout the region: I-20, I-26, I-77, I-95. These interstates make for smooth travel when commuting to the region's major airport and the state's major port.



Crossing east to west over the southern edge of the county, Interstate 20 connects with I-77, I-26 and I-95 just a short ways outside the county's borders.










Columbia Metropolitan Airport (CAE): within a 45 minute drive, it features a UPS air hub and Foreign Trade Zone 127.



DRIVE TIME LABOR FORCE


