


WHY CENTRAL SC?



RICHLAND COUNTY





South Carolina State House

HOME TO SOUTH CAROLINA'S LEGISLATIVE HUB, THE BUILDING HOUSES THE SOUTH CAROLINA GENERAL ASSEMBLY AND THE OFFICES OF THE GOVERNOR AND LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR OF SOUTH CAROLINA.

Riverbanks Zoo & Garden

THE RIVERBANKS ZOO AND GARDEN IS A 170-ACRE ZOO, AQUARIUM, AND BOTANICAL GARDEN LOCATED ALONG THE SALUDA RIVER IN COLUMBIA. IT HAS REPEATEDLY BEEN RANKED AS ONE OF THE STATE'S TOP ATTRACTIONS.

Williams-Brice Stadium

HOME TO THE SOUTH CAROLINA GAMECOCKS FOOTBALL TEAM WILLIAMS-BRICE STADIUM IS CURRENTLY THE 20TH LARGEST COLLEGE FOOTBALL STADIUM IN THE NCAA AND IS LOCATED ON THE CORNER OF GEORGE ROGERS BOULEVARD AND BLUFF ROAD ADJACENT TO THE SOUTH CAROLINA STATE FAIRGROUNDS.
