Also located on the Northeast Campus – just 15 minutes from Columbia's Business District – the Business Accelerator provides flexible, light industrial space for emerging businesses.


This multi-bay building is designed to accommodate several businesses as each ramps up for the next phase of production or delivery of its services and/ or products. The building includes four industrial bays (4,000 square feet each) and four commercial offices (650 square feet each). Utilities, internet, and maintenance are included in rent.


